Leaders cast light when they master ethical challenges of leadership. Leaders cast shadows when they abuse power, mismanage information, and fail to assume responsibilities.

A leader is a person who has an unusual degree of power to create the conditions under which followers can thrive, conditions that can be either as illuminating as heaven or as shadowy as hell. A leader must take special responsibility for what is going on inside his or her own self, inside his or her consciousness, lest the act of leadership create more harm than good. A good leader knows that he must respect himself first, and then respect his brethren and fellow mankind.



For most of us, leadership has a positive connotation. And that is because we have been fortunate enough to benefit from the guidance of our teachers or coaches or counsellors or Imams. We admire noteworthy historical leaders for their great accomplishments. Yet we fail to pay more attention to the shadow side of leadership or the negative dimension of leadership. Political figures, parents, clergy, and business executives almost always have the potential to cast as much shadow as they do light.

Thus, if we refuse to face the dark side of leadership, then we make the leadership abuse of power to become more likely.

Leaders who engage in destructive behaviors and who exhibit dysfunctional personal characteristics undermine the group's success and the well-being of followers. Destructive leaders can be tyrannical and often abuse, bully, manipulate, deceive, and harass followers. Constructive leaders, on the other hand, care about subordinates and help the organization achieve its goals while using resources wisely. When we function as leaders, we take on a unique set of ethical burdens in addition to a set of expectations and tasks. How we handle the challenges of leadership determines whether we cause more harm than good or, whether we cast light or shadow.

As a community, we must always endeavor to enable and enhance good leadership qualities in our organization. We must do this by not ignoring bad leadership, nor by presuming that bad leadership is immutable. Rather, we must call out and fight bad leadership anywhere and everywhere in the organization as we would fight a disease that is always pernicious and sometimes very deadly. We must not be swayed with empty and false promises of better leadership tomorrow. Your leadership and management team is committed to ensuring that good leadership is the norm in MAM going forward.




Hello Miltonians,

Town Report by Zeeshan Hamid



- CEAA ruled that CN has to go through the Federal Environmental Assessment. This is only a small victory as CN is still exempt from the more stringent Provincial and Regional EA.
- Council approved my motion to start work on converting all street lights to LED. In addition to reducing the environmental impact and carbon footprint, cost savings will pay for the conversion in just four years and then will contribute to reducing the tax burden we spend on operating and maintaining street lights.
- ◆ Council approved a 12 story

building adjacent to the GO station parking lot. Another 12 story site is under consideration between the Main Library and the Leisure Centre.

- Derry Road will be closed soon for two days to open the underpass. Region to provide Halton Police officers to direct traffic during the closure.
